## **Admissions under Right to Education Act**

As per the RTE Act, <u>25% seats are reserved at entry level to Class I</u>. As specified in the RTE Act and the Amendment to the act, the following are the criteria's for admission under RTE:

- 1. Children belonging to Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribe, or any other disadvantaged group which is specified by State Government notification
- 2. This definition of disadvantaged group has been extended by the 2012 Amendment to include disabled children, including children with severe disabilities.
- 3. Children belonging to weaker section' are those whose parents' or guardians' annual income is below the poverty line, as specified by the State Government.
- 4. These children should be residing within 3 kms.

## Following documents are required to be submitted for admission under RTE:

- Original Birth certificate for verification along with a photocopy.
- Caste certificate issued by concerned Sub Divisional Officer (Revenue) or Deputy Collector, in the name of child or his parent.
- For disabled children (CWSN) disability certificate issued by Civil Surgeon/Superintendent of Government notified hospital having disability more than 40 per cent.
- Proof of residence. A child is eligible if, the address proof is within 3 km. Any one of the following can be submitted in order of priority -
  - ✓ UID Aadhar Card.
  - ✓ Passport
  - ✓ Election Photo Identity Card. Electricity / Water bill.
  - ✓ Telephone bill.
  - ✓ House tax receipt.
  - ✓ Driving license issued by the competent authority in the name of the parents/guardians.
